Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council are inviting Expressions of Interest from local visual artists to deliver outdoor artworks on existing street furniture or walls across the borough wards, as part of the wider development of the successful Streets Alive project in Basingstoke's town centre. This new phase of the project will be funded by BDBC as part of the Queen's Jubilee borough-wide celebrations.

- Successful artists will work with the ward councillors (and local community associations and action groups) on identifying a suitable location or item of street furniture and appropriate local theme for the artwork.
- Artists may be considered for more than one artwork in more than one ward.
- Artists who have already been involved in the Streets Alive project are also welcome to apply.
- Artists must have a link to North Hampshire and ideally, Basingstoke and Deane

Please also include any experience of creating work in the public realm – we will not necessarily preclude artists with no public art experience, but will provide guidance with relevant information about materials and best practice etc)

e.g: born here, lived or living or working here, attended school here etc – you can also specify which wards from the list below

Any local themes you have already identified or are interested in researching further

e.g.: local people, local landmarks, buildings, sites of natural history or historical events that have occurred in the vicinity

Confirm availability

The work(s) must be completed before the end of March 2023

Timeline for project:

September – ward councillors consulted and call out for Expressions of Interest circulated October – project locations identified. Artists identified November – ward councillors and artists linked, project planning and consultation begins December – Artists designs submitted and signed off (permissions gained on any non BDBC street furniture)

January – March – art implementation

All art must be completed by the end of March 2023

Commission fees (to include all materials, design and painting time):

In the region of £500 per artwork, payable as 80% once letter of agreement is signed and 20% on completion of the artwork
