What is Noisy Noise Noise?

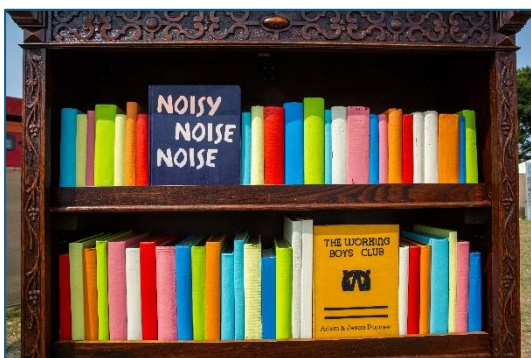
- **Noisy Noise Noise is an artwork you can play with.**

This is a sound-based experience. You are still welcome to visit, look at the artwork, and be with others.

What can I do?

👉 You can press the books.

👂 You can listen to what they do.

😊 You can try different ones and find your favourites.

👤 You can ask a helper if you need support.
